Campground Rules and Policies

Welcome to River Forge RV Park and Campground! Our primary goal is the safety of our campers. We want you to have a fun experience at our campground. In return, we ask that all guests review and follow our campground safety rules. Thank you for choosing our campground!

CAMPGROUND RULES:

- All campers must check in at the store/office on arrival
- Reservation cancellations must be made 72 hours prior to the check-in date. If the cancellation is made after the 72-hour deadline, the deposit will be forfeited.
- Quiet hours: 10:00 pm to 8:00 am
- DO NOT BLOCK INTERIOR ROADS. All vehicles must fit on your site. This is a campground regulation to provide access for emergency vehicles such as fire trucks or ambulances, should they be necessary. Do not block your neighbors, bath houses, pavilions, or playgrounds.
- SPEED LIMIT is 5 MPH – For All Vehicles. Drive carefully and look for children playing.
- Only one vehicle per site. Please do not park vehicles in the grass – if you need additional parking at any time, please notify the staff at the main office.
- Do not walk through, drive onto, or park on other guests' sites.
- Bathhouses are designated for Cabin and Tent Site use ONLY.
- There is a dump station designated for sites without septic hookups.
- Management is not responsible for the loss/theft of personal property. As such, do not leave anything unattended in the bath houses, pavilions, or on campsites. Staff, owners, and owners' heir(s) shall not be held liable for accidents, loss of property, theft, damage to personal property, or bodily injury.
- Trees, shrubs, and plants may not be cut or damaged.
- No loose garbage. Please place garbage in the dumpsters.

- Campsites are to be kept neat, clean, and free of clutter. Management reserves the right to inspect campground lots at any time. If a violation occurs, management will ask that you clean the area or remove your camper from the campground.
- No dumping of sewage or water from your camper onto the ground.
- Do not deposit substances into toilets or plumbing fixtures which could damage or interfere with the operation or maintenance of the fixture.
- Pets MUST be always on a leash. Clean up after pets and dispose of waste in the trash. Dogs cannot be tethered to a dog line.
- No exotic pets or aggressive dogs/animals. If any pet/animal exhibits aggressive behavior, the guest will be asked to remove the animal from the premises.
- Absolutely no hunting on campground property.
- Do not leave campfires unattended. All campfires must be contained in a fire ring or fire pit. You are responsible for your own campfire. All campfires must be in safe and convenient areas where they will not constitute fire hazards to vegetation, undergrowth, trees, recreational vehicles, RVs, campers, vehicles, buildings, structures, etc.
- No fireworks.
- No firearms brandished while on the property.
- Be respectful of other campers.
- Alcohol must be in a covered container. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. Management has the right to expel you from the campground. If you are expelled from the campground, you will not be issued a refund.
- Do not engage in fighting, horseplay, roughhousing, wrestling, etc.
- No vulgar or offensive signs/images are to be displayed in public view.
- Lewd behavior, profanity, and nudity will not be tolerated at any time.
- Campers are expected to adhere to all local, state, and federal laws.
- Common Areas which include pavilions and firepits, are intended for use by all guests. No guest will be excluded from any common area unless the area has been reserved for a specific group or purpose with prior approval from management. Reservations are subject to review by management and must be submitted 72 hours in advance.
- No refund will be given after your reservation date begins. No exceptions.
